Feeding the Gulf Coast serves a 24-county area spanning the Florida Panhandle, South Alabama, and South Mississippi. In 2022, the food bank distributed nearly 29 million meals to more than 800 community partners, including church pantries, soup kitchens, child nutrition sites and other nonprofit organizations throughout its service area. The food bank also operates multiple hunger-relief and nutrition programs, including Summer and Afterschool Meals, Backpack and School Pantries, Disaster Relief, Mobile Pantry and Produce Drop Distributions and Nutrition Education. Feeding the Gulf Coast is a United Way member agency and a member of Feeding America.

For every dollar donated, 5 meals are generated for those in need.
