Recent hunger statistics released confirmed what we have witnessed in our community. The 31% rise in overall food insecurity alone is staggering. However, particularly distressing is the disproportionate impact on children, with hunger rates soaring by 44% compared to previous years, marking the most significant one-year increase since 2008. A mission of this magnitude requires a thoughtful and strategic approach. That is why we took a long, hard look at our current strategic plan to chart a course forward that will be maximally impactful for those we serve and our community. What resulted

was a more streamlined plan that built off previous successes but put a stronger focus on efficiency and equity of distribution throughout the communities we serve.

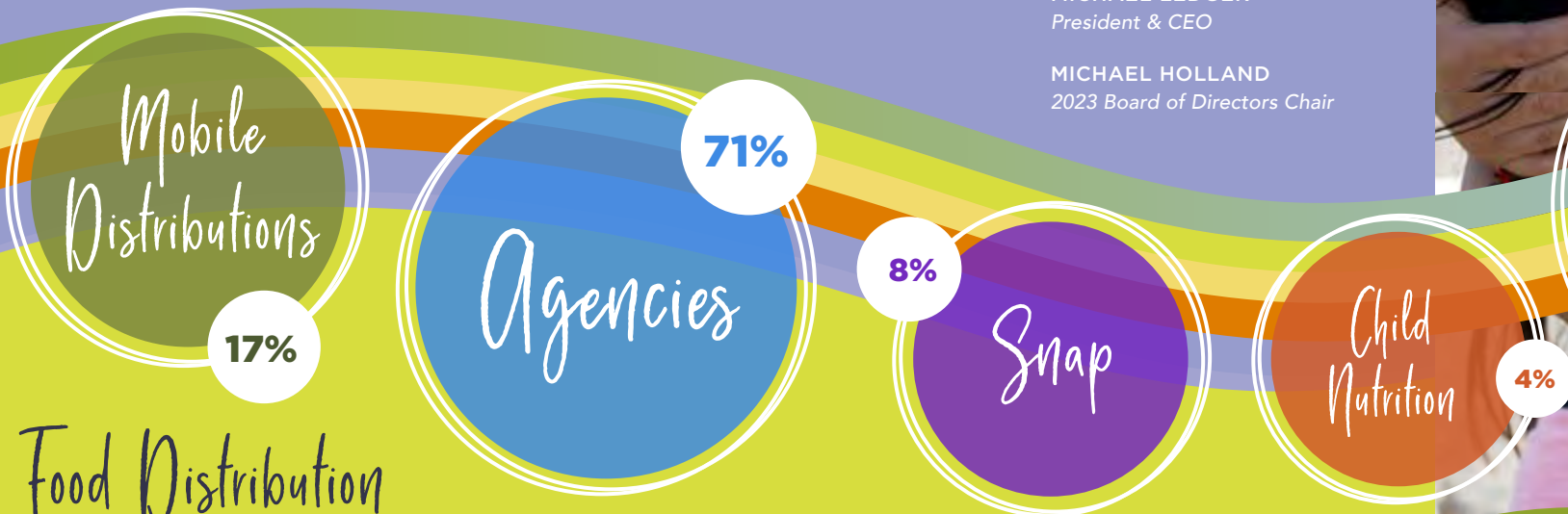

You—our volunteers, donors, and friends, made this monumental effort possible. We extend our heartfelt gratitude for your continued partnership and recognize that we are truly stronger together.

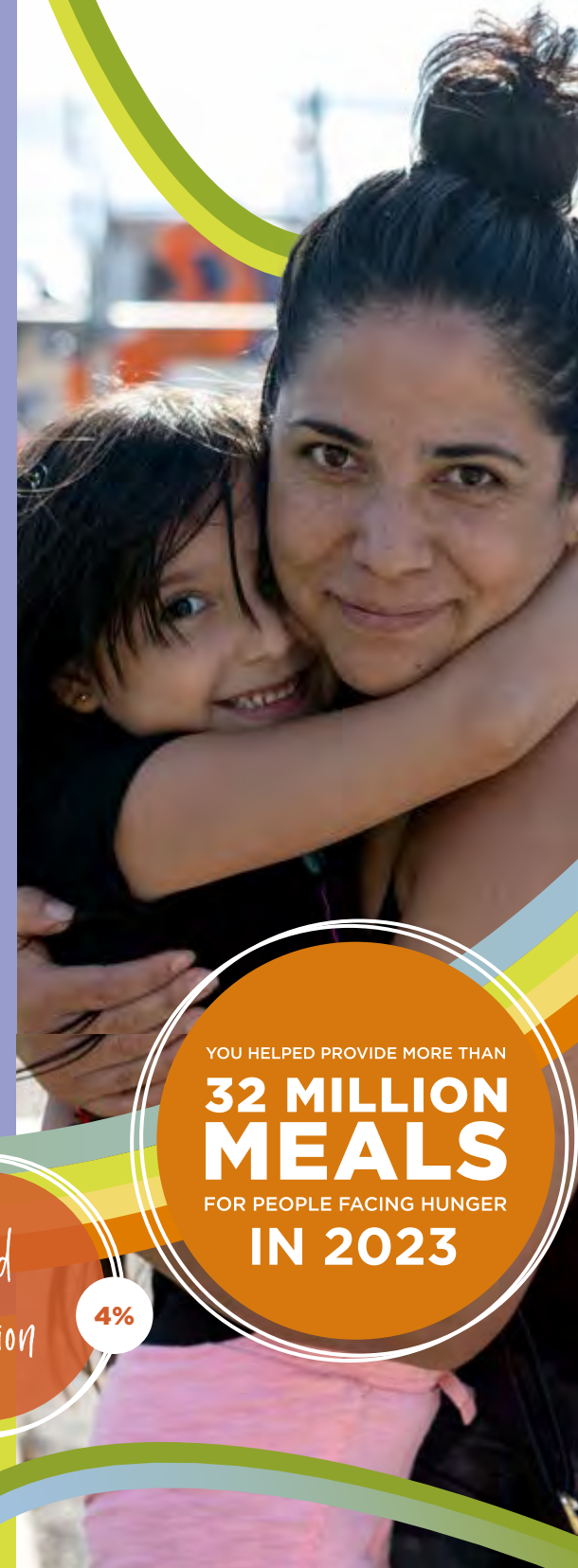

Feed

reflects our commitment to sustainable food sourcing, fair distribution, efficient operations, and expanding access to nutritious meals to combat food insecurity.

Nourish

reflects our focus on improving access to nutritious foods through the use of data-informed approaches and engaging communities through education and partnerships to boost nutrition and health outcomes.

Equip

reflects our increased focus on leveraging technology and connecting with community resources to better serve our neighbors and break the cycle of poverty.

Engage

reflects our approach to engaging stakeholders by building partnerships, raising awareness, and securing ongoing support through fundraising, advocacy, and volunteer efforts.

Inspiring Impact for Our Neighbors



Feeding the Gulf Coast cultivates relationships with our federal, state, and local elected officials to amplify the voices of those facing food insecurity and engage key representatives in driving change and strengthening policies that create systemic progress in ending hunger for our most vulnerable populations.

Feeding the Gulf Coast operates multiple Federal Nutrition Programs, supported by the Farm Bill, that are instrumental in providing the resources needed to combat hunger. These equip our community partners to expand their capacity to better serve hungry families, children, and seniors across the Gulf Coast. The Emergency Food Assistance Program, the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), and the Commodity Supplemental Food Program provide relief to low-income families, seniors, children, and individuals who otherwise would miss countless meals. These programs alone accounted for 42% of the meals distributed across our service area last year.

Congress reviews the Farm Bill every five years, making key decisions on how to address and support agricultural and food issues comprehensively. Through advocacy initiatives, Feeding the Gulf Coast works with policymakers to convey the significant need for food assistance and to demonstrate how essential Farm Bill programs are in supporting our efforts to reach neighbors facing hunger across the central Gulf Coast. Last year, the food bank actively engaged with legislators and staffers to advocate for legislation, policy implementation, and appropriations that impact our work. This collective effort earned Feeding the Gulf Coast top recognition on Food Bank News' Advocacy High Honor Roll.

Nourishing Individuals

The Vital Connection Between Food & Wellness

Everyone needs consistent access to food to be healthy and happy. For people facing food insecurity, the challenge of proper nutrition can create a cycle of tough choices that results in otherwise manageable conditions becoming a health crisis.

Helping Communities Thrive

With the launch of its Community Health & Nutrition division last year, the food bank worked to develop nutrition education and health programming to engage individuals and families who utilize food, health, and human services at relevant partners.



Nutrition Education

These science-backed classes create an avenue of attainable steps that clients can use to inform their choices regarding diet and meal planning.

One of the first classes was hosted at a Summer Meal Program event. Nutrition Specialists taught the kids how to create fruit parfaits with Greek yogurt. One little boy enjoyed it so much that he wanted to save half of his to take home and share with his mom.

At the Farm to City Distribution, the team conducted 500 taste tests and provided recipients with a recipe for one of the locally grown produce items they received.



Healthcare Partnerships

Feeding the Gulf Coast presented alongside Feeding America's CEO, Claire Babineaux-Fontenot, at the NDORI's Annual Health Summit for Health Care Professionals in Biloxi, MS. As the keynote speaker, Claire was able to address how food insecurity and chronic disease correlate. This opportunity gave our team an audience with the region's most active healthcare professionals addressing food-related illnesses. By connecting with healthcare providers to address food insecurity as a social determinant of health, we can grow our *Food as Medicine* initiatives to improve health outcomes.



Mobile Market

Work to prepare Millie, the Mobile Market was completed during the fall of 2023. The Mobile Market program will offer reduced-cost items, at least 20% below market prices, to households that lack easy access to nutritious food.

The Community Health and Nutrition team laid the groundwork to identify routes in underserved locations for opportunities to connect the community with an affordable source of fresh, local produce.

Strengthening Resources

Expansion of Retail Store Partners Grows Our Efforts

Recognized by Feeding America for our strong partnerships with local retail stores, the food bank was awarded two significant grants to expand our efforts. These grants enable us to support agencies in providing neighbors with nutritious foods that are not readily accessible in many of the areas we serve.

This investment in our food sourcing capacity is even more critical due to our predominantly rural service area, where access to grocery stores and fresh foods is limited or unavailable.

Through this funding, Feeding the Gulf Coast began the work to onboard nearly 400 Dollar General stores across the communities we serve. This expansion greatly improves access and capacity for our partners serving rural areas.

Equipping Our Partners



Thanks to capacity building grants, the food bank made significant investments in its partner agencies last year, specifically focusing on traditionally hard to reach rural communities facing food insecurity. The grants allowed the food bank to grow its retail rescue programs by purchasing equipment and investing in training.

The pandemic greatly heightened the need for food assistance in our communities, and unfortunately, that increased demand remains. As a result, many of our partners continue to struggle to provide enough food for the growing number of families, individuals, and children facing hunger. To meet this challenge, the food bank has made critical investments to help our partners build capacity and better serve their communities.

Addressing hunger requires more than just food—it involves strengthening the infrastructure of our network to ensure access for all. By equipping our partners to expand their reach and operate more efficiently and safely, we're working to close the gap in access to nutritious food and provide consistent support across our service area. This commitment to capacity investments ensures that our partners can meet the needs of those impacted by hunger.

Building capacity in our network means bringing new partners to the table, providing training, procuring new equipment, and inspiring more people to join the movement to end hunger. These generous grants add up to a significant, meaningful increase in the amount of food we are making available in our community.

Building Capacity

The Need to Invest in Underserved Communities

“Our community is extremely poor—the annual average income is about \$20,000. I think that number alone gives credence to the dire situation of most families,” says Mary, who runs the Vernon Community Food Pantry in Vernon, Florida. Last year, Feeding the Gulf Coast received Retail Agency Capacity grants to invest in its network of partners. Thanks to this funding, Mary’s pantry received equipment assets such as a cooler to assist with picking up donations from retail stores. The pantry went from serving a handful of families to nearly 100 at a time. They can also now accept donations of fresh produce, meat, and dairy.

“If it were not for Feeding the Gulf Coast and the wonderful things they do for us, I don’t know that we would’ve been able to continue this food pantry.”



Accelerating Solutions

The Unseen Neighbors Facing Hunger

In 2023, Feeding the Gulf Coast set out to extend added support to some of the most vulnerable members of our community—children in rural areas, seniors, and military families. These groups often face unique challenges in accessing nutritious food, exacerbated by geographic location or the demands of service life.

We implemented targeted outreach initiatives to address these barriers, including food distributions and partnerships with local schools, senior centers, and military installations—aiming to ensure that no child goes hungry while trying to learn, no senior skips needed meals, and no military family struggles while serving our country.

Through these expanded efforts, we are combating hunger and fostering a sense of community among those who might otherwise go unseen.

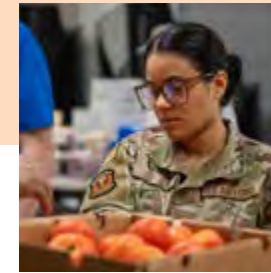
Expanding Reach



Children

Last year, we partnered with nearly 200 schools to distribute more than 624,100 meals through the Backpack and School Pantry programs, which reduce child hunger by providing food to kids on the weekends.

Recognizing a gap in coverage throughout our rural counties, the food bank actively sought to expand our programs to an additional 41 sites.



Military

Last year, we identified collaborative organizations near military bases to support efforts in combating food insecurity for Veterans, active-duty, and retired military personnel.

Working directly with these organizations and local military bases, we have established access points to provide assistance to service members and their families.



Seniors

Last year, through CSFP, the food bank addressed senior hunger by providing monthly food boxes of nutritious staples to more than 3,000 low-income seniors, aged 60 and older.

By establishing our privately funded senior-focused healthy food box initiative, the food bank expanded its efforts to reach an additional 3,000 older individuals.
