About Us

Feeding the Gulf Coast (FTGC) serves 24 counties spanning South Alabama, South Mississippi, and the Florida Panhandle. In 2024, the food bank distributed more than 35 million meals through more than 800 community partners throughout its service area. Beyond food distribution, the food bank operates multiple hunger relief and nutrition programs, including child and senior nutrition programs, benefits outreach, nutrition education, and disaster relief. A four-star rated organization by Charity Navigator, Feeding the Gulf Coast is one of the most efficient nonprofits nationally, with over 98% of all donations being put back into the community. For every dollar donated, 5 meals are generated for those in need.
